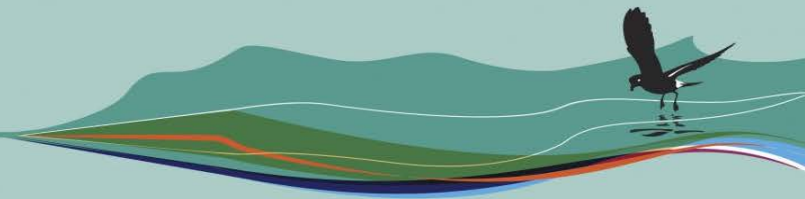

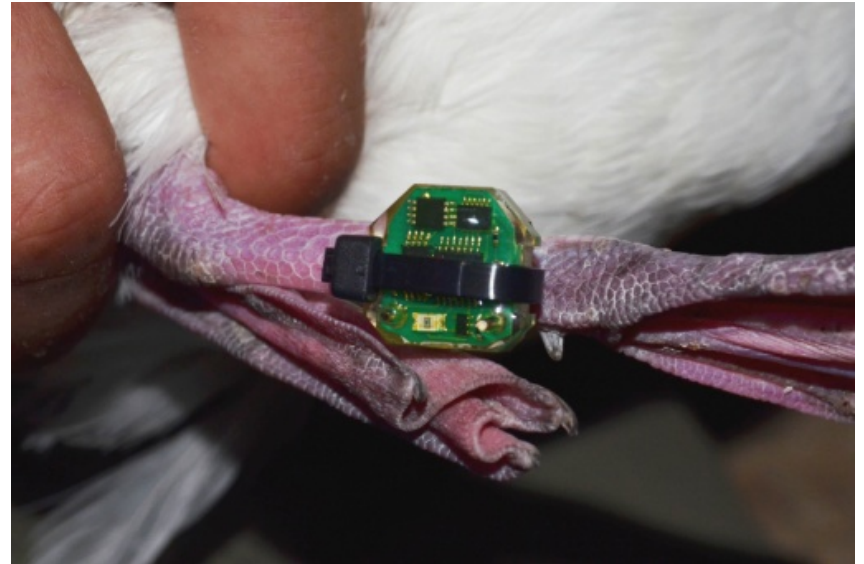

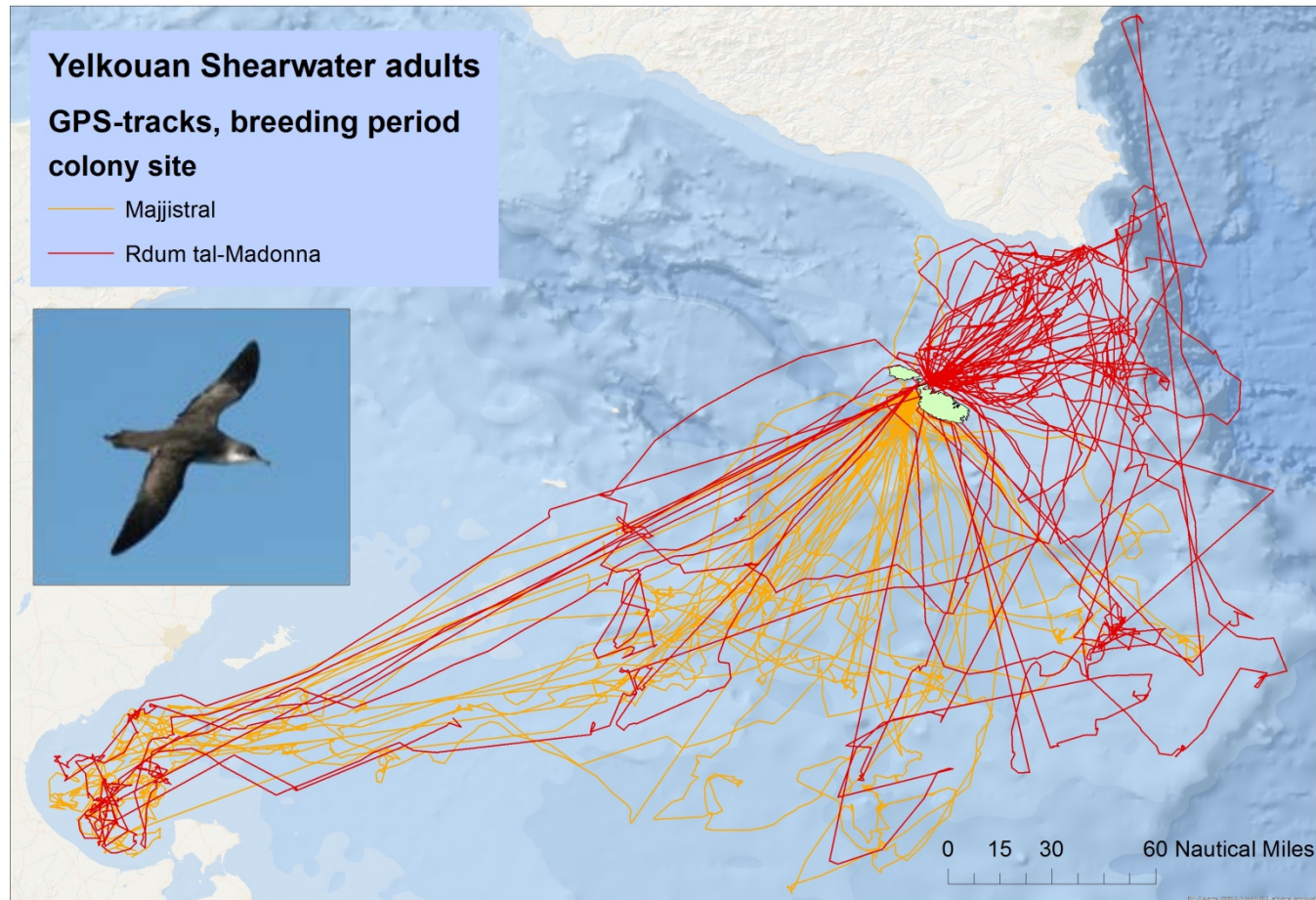
GPS-tracking during the breeding season (foraging trips)



GLS-tracking during the annual cycle: migration, wintering

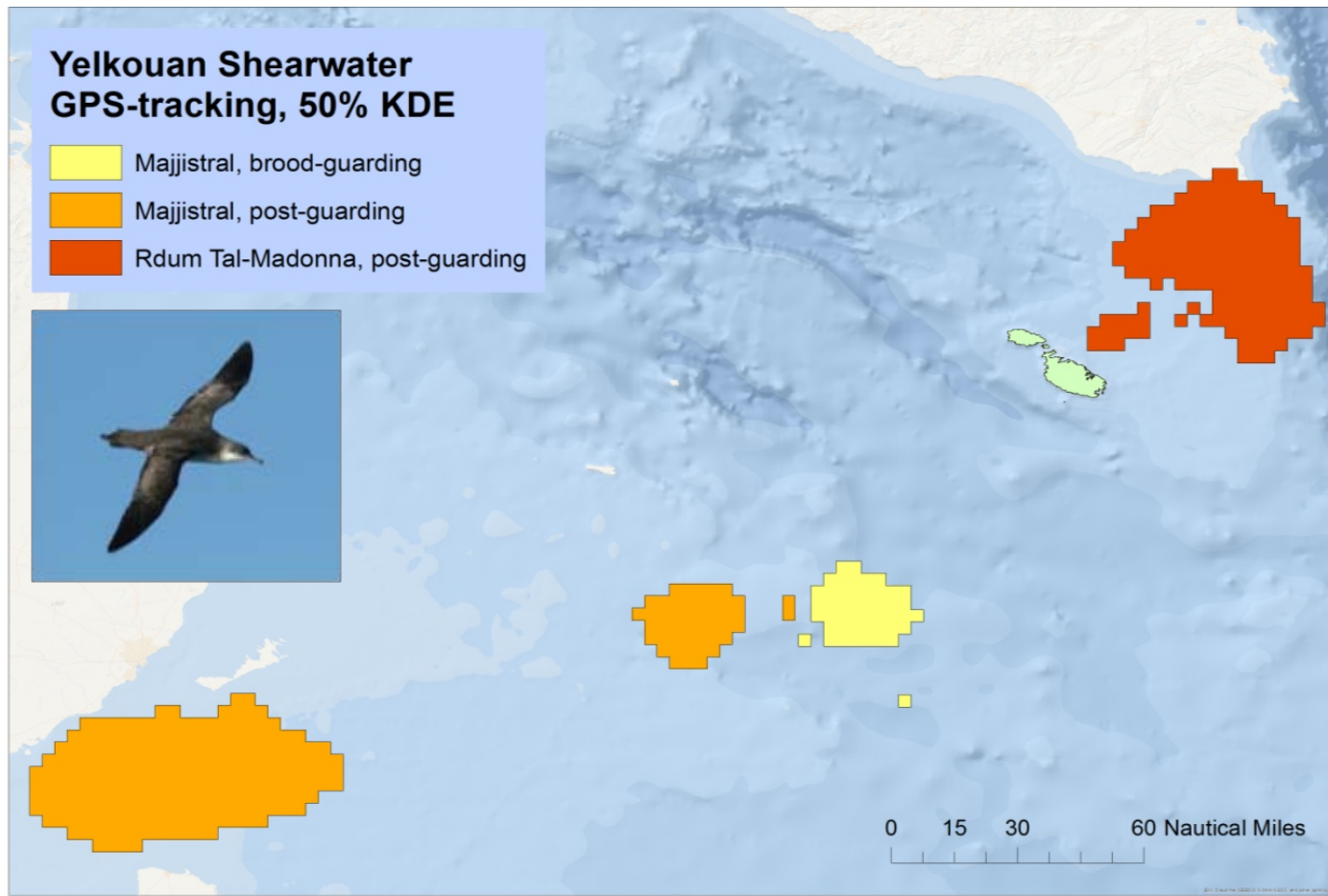


Results from GPS-tracking Maltese Yelkouan Shearwaters from two colonies during three breeding seasons

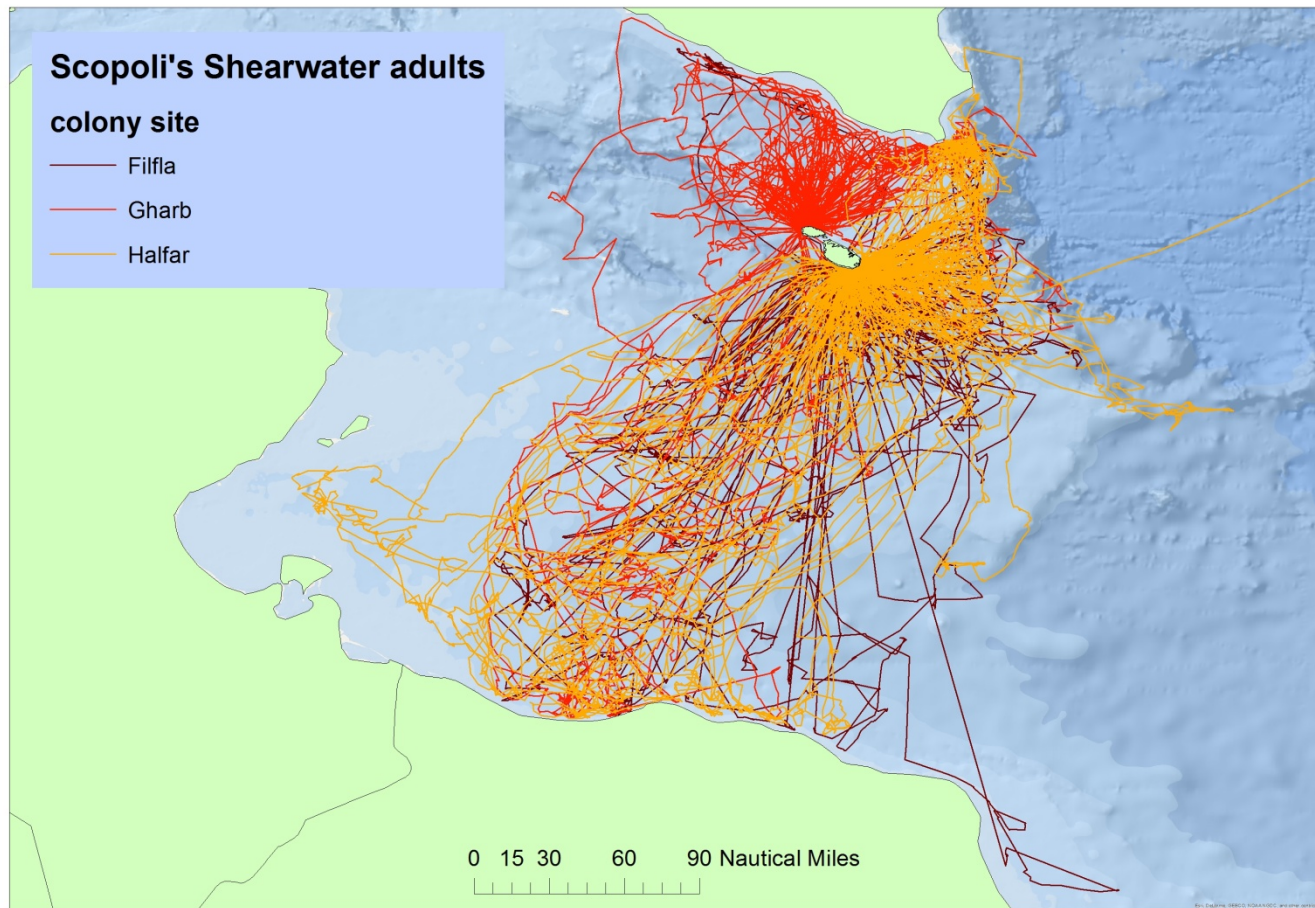


Results from GPS-tracking Maltese Yelkouan Shearwaters

Important areas South of Sicily, off Tunisia and SE of Lampedusa

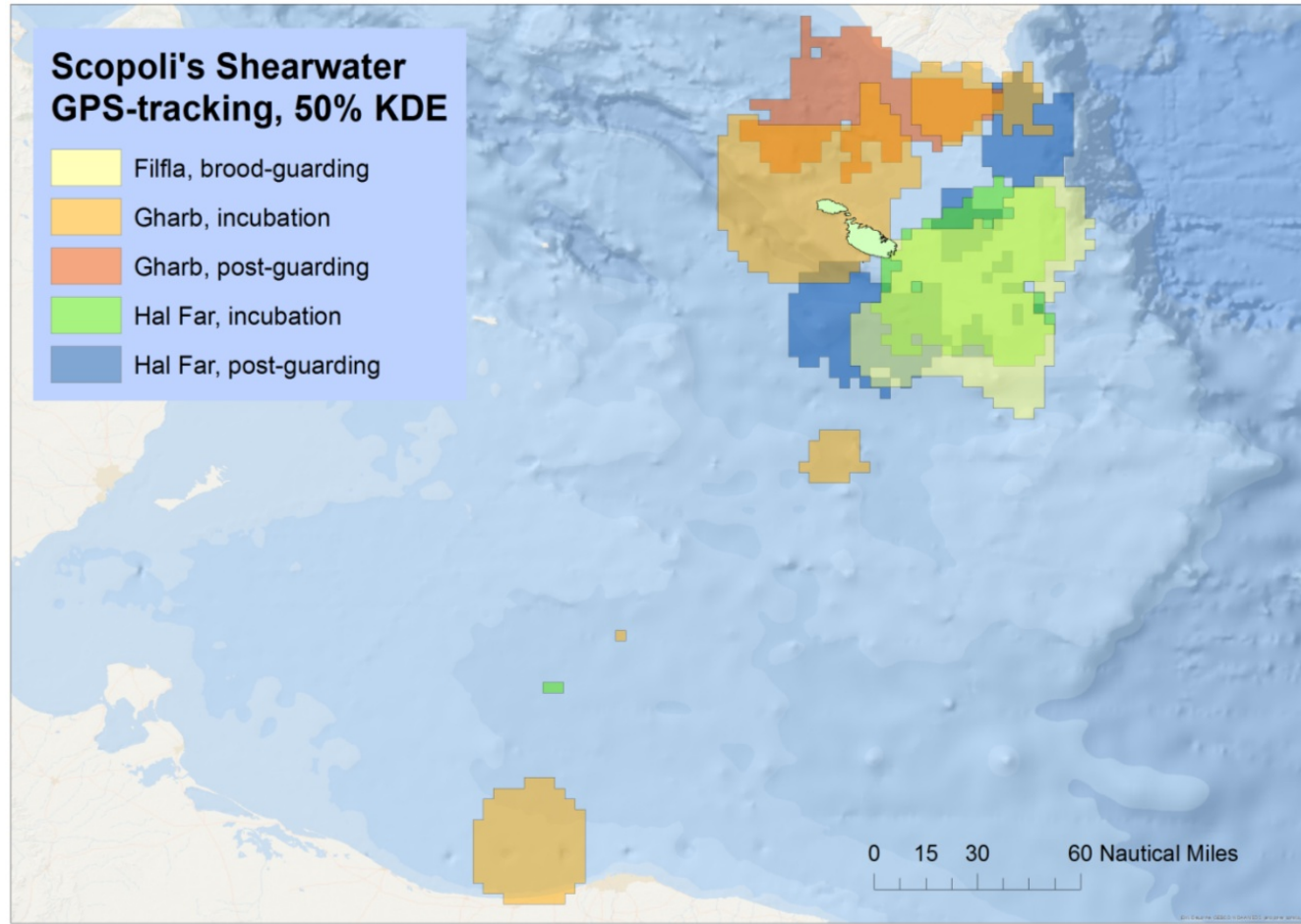


Results from GPS-tracking Maltese Scopoli's Shearwaters from three colonies during three breeding seasons

Important areas South of Sicily, SE and S of Malta and in front of Libya



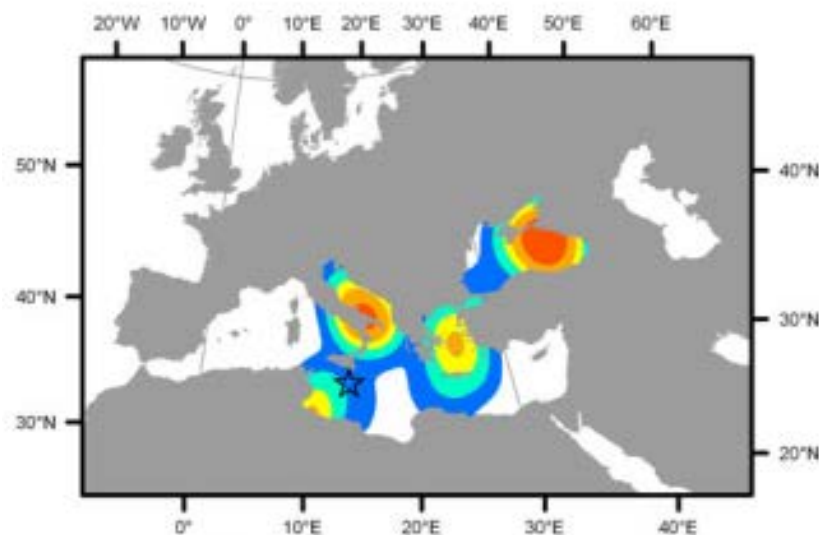

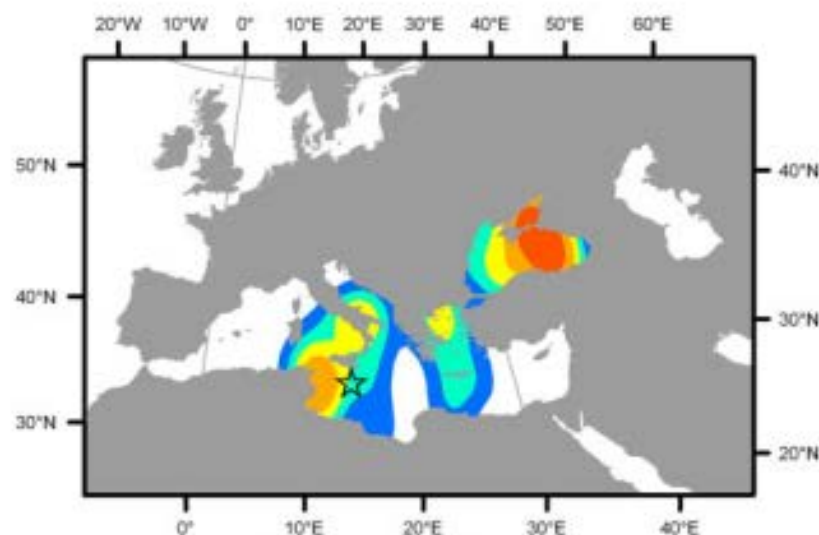

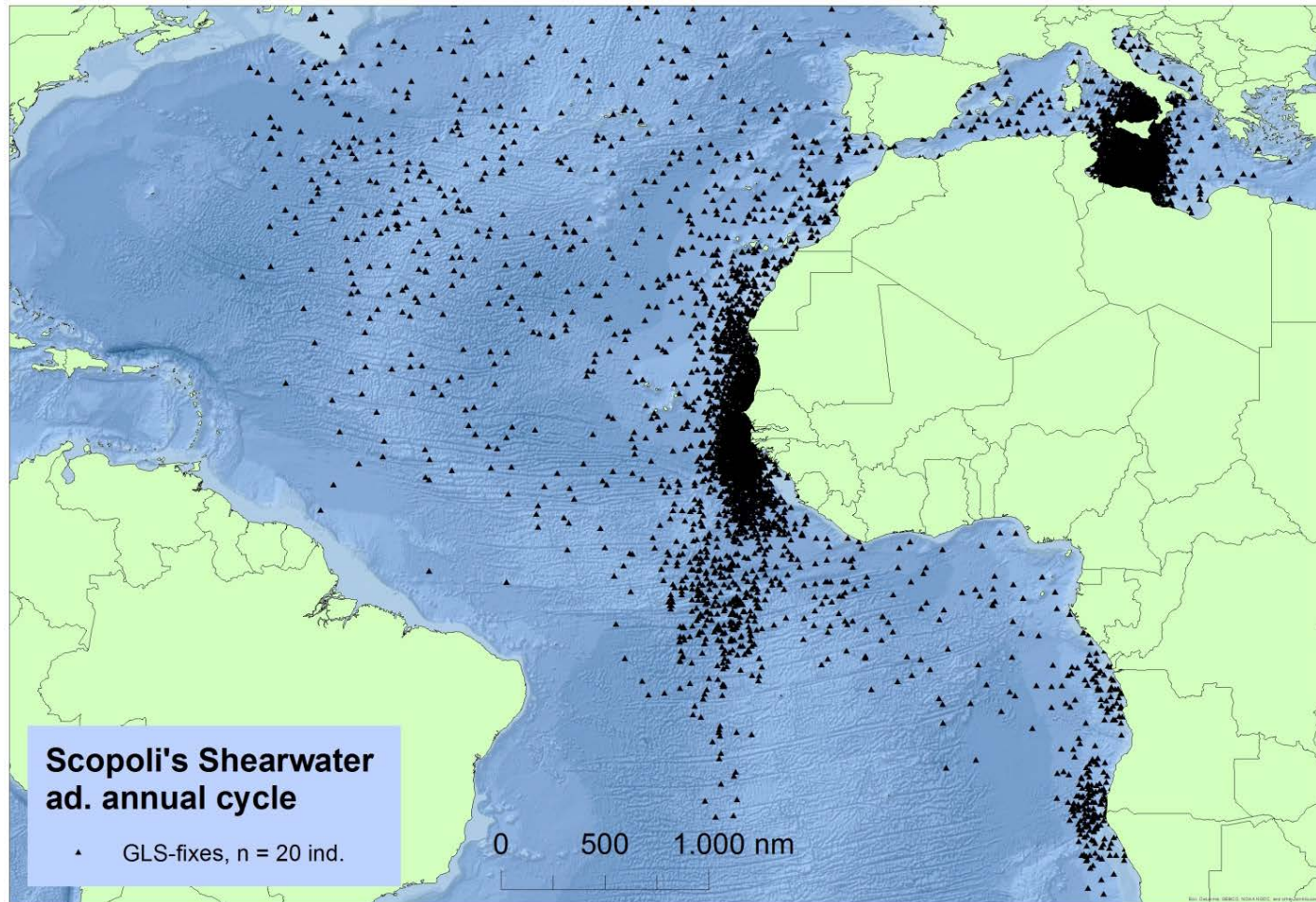
(a) July-August



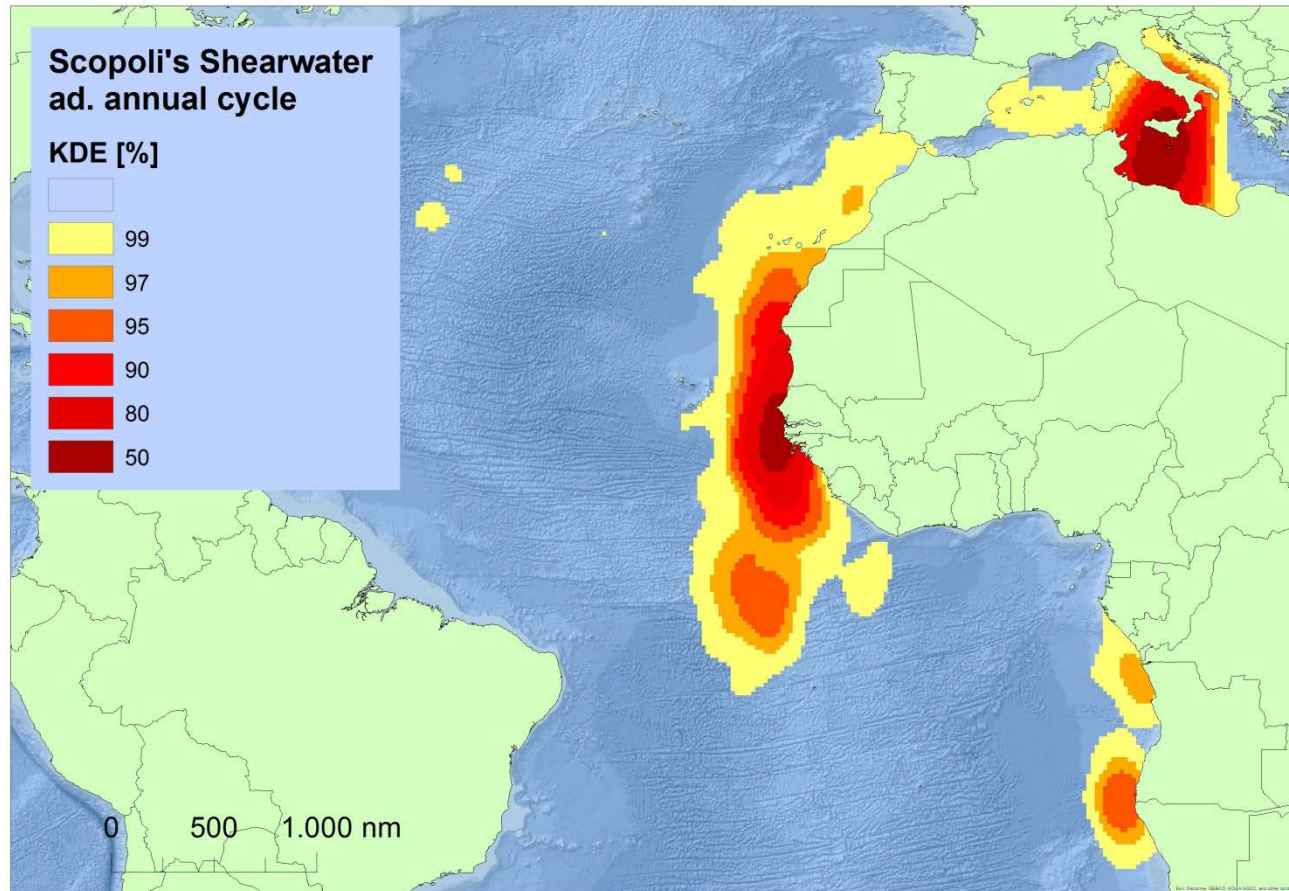
(b) September-October



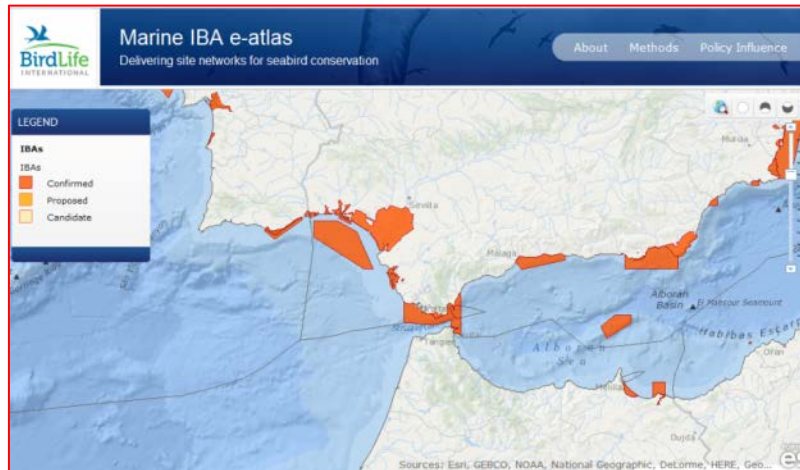

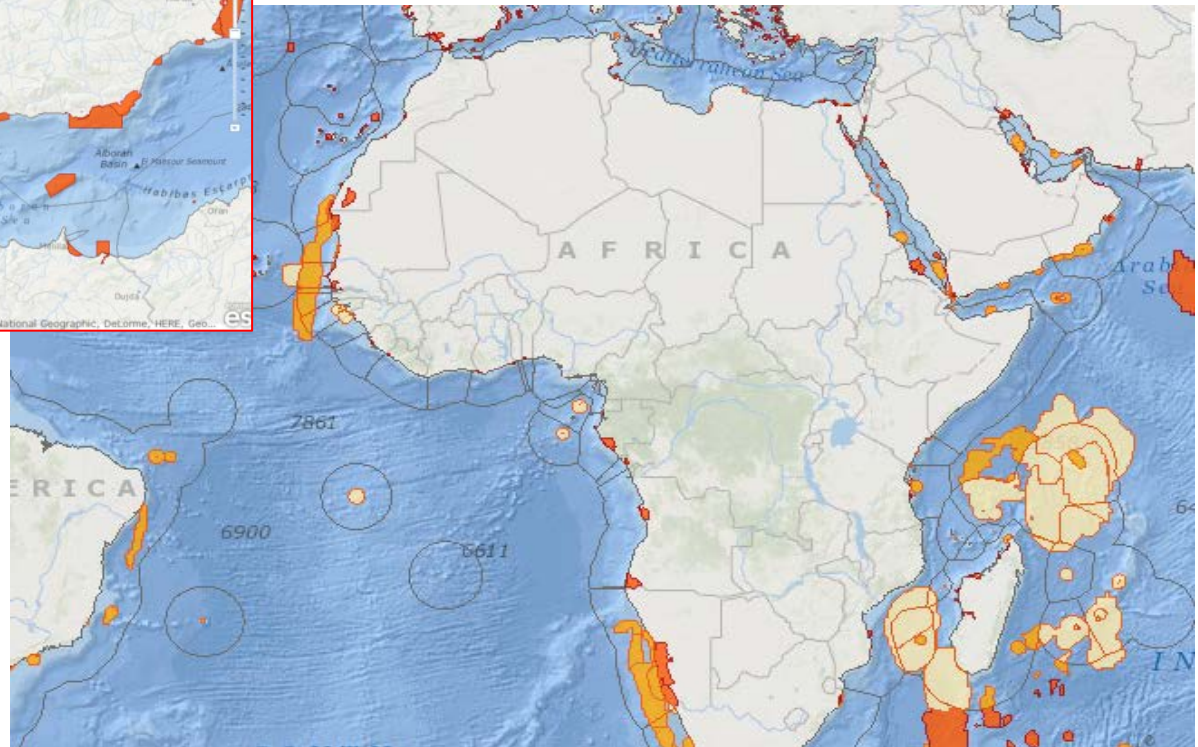


Matching Maltese results with existing mIBA network (e-atlas)
